



Missie D'Aunoy Memorial Scholarship

The Missie D'Aunoy Memorial Scholarship was established in January 2014 to honor the memory of Missie D'Aunoy who passed on March 3rd, 2013, at the age of 56.

Missie was an active and important member of the Diocese of Phoenix, as well a parishioner and member of the Finance Council at St. John Vianney Catholic Church and School. Mrs. D'Aunoy worked diligently in many capacities to assist the varied needs of the parishioners of the Diocese of Phoenix. At St. Vincent De Paul School, she helped create the school's first computer lab, and an additional basketball court for the school community. With Habitat for Humanity, she helped create and fund homes for those in need, and as Director of the Office of Stewardship she worked to further diocesan stewardship, oversaw planning and development, and spearheaded the annual Catholic Charity & Development Appeal (CDA). Missie devoted herself generously and tirelessly to our Diocese.

The Missie D'Aunoy Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a St. John Vianney 8th grade student planning on attending a Catholic high school. The criteria for consideration for this scholarship are the completion of this application and essay, as well as excellence in the academic areas of math and science. The scholarship will be paid in four installments directly to the predetermined Catholic high school each July prior to the start of each of the student's academic years.

St. John Vianney Catholic School is proud and honored to award the Missie D'Aunoy Memorial Scholarship. The D'Aunoy family seeks to award the scholarship to a student from St. John Vianney Catholic School who will actively pursue a superior Catholic high school education culminating in graduation and higher education.
